





The plant makes cardboard boxes for the agriculture industry, said Salinas Deputy Fire Chief Brett Loomis.





### FAMU searching for two anti-hazing administrators

Florida A&M University has started nationwide searches to hire a high-level administrator to oversee anti-hazing initiatives and a compliance officer for the famed Marching 100 band. The jobs — Special Assistant to the President for Anti-Hazing and Music Department Compliance Officer - also will be advertised in Diverse Issues in Higher Education and the Chronicle of Higher Education.

The new searches were launched two weeks after FAMU began a nationwide search for a new director of Marching and Pen Bands. All three positions will play leading roles in implementing new policies and procedures involving the Marching 100, which has been suspended for the 2012-13 academic year following last vear's hazing death of drum major Robert Champion. Larry Robinson, FAMU's interim president, said the goal is to have all three positions filled by the end of the fall 2012 semester.

#### TCC receives \$35K grant

The Tallahassee Community College Foundation has received \$35,000 as part of the Innovation Generation grant program from the charitable arm of Motorola Solutions Inc.


Through the grant, the TCC Foundation will improve student science achievement through family science and teacher development.


Since 2007, the Motorola Solutions program has provided \$30 million in support of science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) education programs across the United States.

### Storm damage still being tallied


The National Weather Service is still assessing damage from Tuesday afternoon's storm.

emerging and holding its own with an economy led by agriculture, agtech and lately, cannabis.






